ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Adarsh Vidyalaya, Mowa has once again demonstrated its unwavering commitment to academic excellence by achieving an outstanding 100% pass result in the CBSE Board Examinations 2025, both in the All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) and the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE).

In the AISSE (Class X) Examination 2025, the school recorded remarkable performance with 12 students securing above 90%, while 45 students scored more than 80%, reflecting the institution's consistent academic standards and dedication to quality education. Vishal Sahu secured 97% and emerged as the school topper, followed by Kriti Verma (96.8%), Arpan Tiwari (96.4%), Sourabh Nayak (95.2%), Srishti Mishra (94.6%), Shreya Garg (92.8%), Anwesha Singh (92.6%), Shreya Singh (90.8%), Sonam Sahu (90.6%), Gourav Selokar (90.4%), Prachi Karn (90.4%), and Jins James Thomas (90%).

In the AISSCE (Class XII) Examination 2025, the school also achieved a 100% pass result with 15 students scoring above 90% and 45 students securing more than 80%. In the Commerce stream, Shiv Hema and Anjali Bachchani emerged as joint school toppers with 95.2%, followed by Prachi Bachchani (94%), Bhumika Verma (93.6%), Nidhi Darudkar Soni (93.4%), Madhulika Kundu (92.8%), Muskan Baghele (91.6%), Ritika Patel (91.6%), Janhvi Sahu (91.6%), Prakhar Singh (91.2%), Aryan Sahu (90.4%), G. Vanshika (90.4%), Suresh Dhanush (90.2%), Nilav Singh (90.2%), and Bhumi Bhawani (90%).
